

VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

Full information clause on using the video surveillance system by the controller for persons on the premises of the production facility of „Milarex” sp. z o.o.

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of personal data of 27/04/2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of their personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46/EC, OJ EU L 119 of 04/05/2016. (hereinafter referred to as the GDPR), I would like to inform you that:

1.

The Controller of personal data obtained in relation to the surveillance is "MILAREX" Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością, with its registered office in Słupsk (76-200), ul. Braci Staniuków 36, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register maintained by the District Court of Gdańsk-North in Gdańsk, 8th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS: number 0000209848, REGON: 771483688, NIP: 8392756807; telephone number: (59) 722 06 00; e-mail address: office@milarex.com, hereinafter referred to as the "Controller."

2.

In order to ensure the safety of persons staying on the premises of the facility, including suppliers, visitors and other third parties, and to protect property, as well as for the purpose of production control, the Controller at the production facility at ul. Braci Staniuków 36 in Słupsk uses a video surveillance system allowing the registration of images (hereinafter referred to as the "video surveillance").

The legal basis for the processing of personal data from video surveillance is Article 6(1)(f) GDPR. The Controller's legitimate interest is the need to ensure the safety of persons in the buildings and on the premises of the Controller's production facility, including ensuring the safety of the Controller's employees, suppliers and visitors and the security of the Controller's property, as well as the need to verify persons on the premises of the production facility, the need to ensure production control and the need to establish and assert potential claims by the Controller and to protect against them.

4.

The area of the Controller's production facility (excluding sanitary facilities, changing rooms and smoking rooms), as well as the area around the facility, is covered by the video surveillance. The Controller is to visibly and legibly mark the premises and area to be monitored with appropriate graphic signs.

5.

The Controller processes image recordings from the video surveillance system only for the purpose indicated in Section 2 above.

6.

The Controller retains surveillance recordings for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days, unless the recordings constitute evidence in proceedings under the law or The Controller has become aware that they may constitute evidence in such proceedings, in which case the retention period of the recordings is extended until the legal conclusion of such proceedings. After the expiry of the retention periods referred to in the previous sentence, said recordings containing personal data are to be destroyed, unless otherwise provided under law.

7.

You have the following rights as regards your personal data: to access your personal data, to erase, to restrict its processing or to its portability, as well as to object to its processing and lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority under the terms and conditions of the data protection legislation. The data subject's right of access may be restricted in justified cases such as the protection of personal data of other persons included in the video surveillance area or the investigation of claims and proceedings by authorities under law.

8.

Your provision of data is voluntary, yet necessary for you to stay on the premises of the Controller's production facility.
